Obsessed by the memory of her, he invites red-haired prostitutes to his home whom he kills after cruelly torturing them. Subsequently, after having fallen for Gladys, a stripper, he marries her. All continues peacefully until Evelyn's ghost appears and certain guests die under mysterious circumstances. New events further upset the fragile mental state of Alan, until once again the Baronet is admitted to a clinic. But all is not what it seems, someone is trying to trick him out of his fortune...

Director Emilio P. Miraglia melds the giallo's trademark twisty whodunit storytelling with gothic chills, concocting a gripping horror/thriller hybrid. Populated by an array of Euro cult stars, including Giacomo Rossi Stuart (Caltiki the Immortal Monster) and the unforgettable Erika Blanc (Kill, Baby... Kill!), and featuring a lush lounge score by giallo maestro Bruno Nicolai, The Night Evelyn Came Out of the Grave offers up a beguiling, unique and downright insane twist on a familiar formula.
